Events and Philanthropies Fall 2019

Alpha Delta

- Completed 2,100 hours of community service
 - Participate in SafeWalk program

Alpha Sigma Tau

- Raised over \$134.25 for nonprofit organizations
 - Philanthropic organizations are embody “Women Supporting Women”
- Completed 180 hours of community service

Gamma Sigma Sigma

- Raised \$289.80 for nonprofit organizations
- Completed 1,639.80 hours of community service

Academics

Fall 2019 the overall community semester grade point average (GPA) increased by 0.20 from Spring 2019 semester.

Alpha Sigma Tau has the highest chapter semester GPA of 3.16; which is above the campus average GPA and only 0.03 behind the campus women's GPA.

Omicron Delta Kappa

Omicron Delta Kappa (ODK) is an honors society that focuses on leadership.
